Materials

Give each child a bookmark. Allow them to choose a design they like or help them swap with a friend.

Let the children decorate the bookmark as they would like to and tie ribbon through the hole at the end.

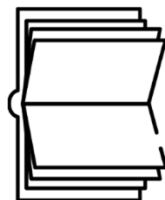
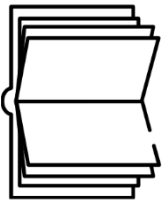

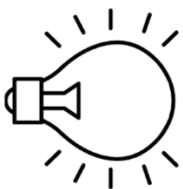
